Early Childhood Mental Health Consultant

The Early Childhood Consultant can provide individual and family therapy to improve child development, healthy attachment, and build resilience in families.

The Nurturing Parenting Program is also available for families who are court-ordered to complete a parenting curriculum. The Nurturing Parenting Program is designed to enhance parents' self-awareness and thereby increase their understanding of their children.
